ELIJAH FREDERICK



5. DO YOU EVER SUFFER FROM WRITERS BLOCK?


Sometimes I do get a writers block, especially when I write fiction. To overcome this, I find that planning my work helps me to overcome this.

6. WHAT IS THE MESSAGE IN YOUR BOOK?



The message in my book is that if you have been bullied and encountered challenges everything will turn out alright if you stay true to yourself.




